An Accu-quilt is professional die cutting machine that cuts quilt shapes. It quickly and easily cuts up to 10 layers of fabric at a time. No more aching hands, inaccurate cuts or wasting fabric. Come join our club and schedule your own personal time on the machine to cut your next quilt. No meetings to attend. Collect your scraps and make your own charm squares and jelly rolls. Purchase new fabric and cut out your quilt quickly so you can get right to the sewing. Membership is \$30.00 for 6 sessions at 2 hours each. The more members we have the more dies we can buy. 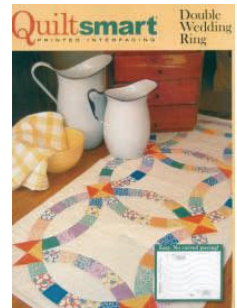

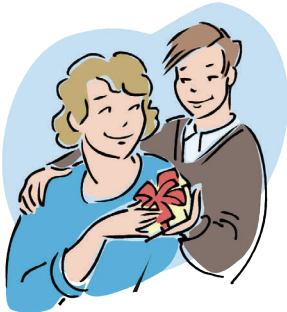
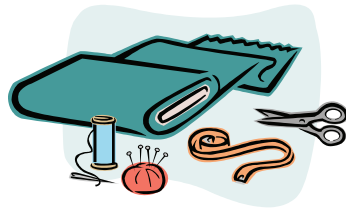
